- 8. Event Schedule:
 - Sunday 14th September Individual arrivals of participating countries at San Francisco airport. Transfers to Hotel Check

in - buffet dinner at the hotel (7-9pm)

- Monday 15th September breakfast @ hotel practice day on courts (buffet lunch and BBQ dinner at the tennis club)
- Tuesday 16th September breakfast @ hotel Doubles Men, Doubles Women, Junior Doubles and awards (buffet lunch and taco dinner at the tennis club)
- Wednesday 17th September breakfast @ hotel Singles Men, Singles Women, Singles Junior and awards (buffet lunch & Chinese dinner at the tennis club)
- Thursday 18th September breakfast @ hotel 6 hour tour of San Francisco, including the Golden Gate Bridge, Fisherman's Wharf, and Union Square-for shopping – Farewell Dinner at 6pm @ the hotel
- Friday 19th September breakfast than check out from the hotel in the morning. Individual transfers to airport – Check in & individual departures... 'Bon Voyage'
- 9. Eligibility:

a) Participating players shall be those who have been approved by those National Soft Tennis Associations/Federations which are the member countries of the ISTF

b) Players shall have the nationality of the countries they shall represent -

c) Participating head of team &/or coaches shall be those who have been approved by the respective organizations of the countries they will represent

d) The Sponsor of the event shall be allowed to invite recommended players.

10. Entries:

1) The countries taking part in the event may participate with a maximum of 10 (ten) members of which 6 (six) to 8 (eight) are players – men, women and juniors (15 years and under), 1 (one) coach & 1 (one) team leader and their mates, or any combination of leaders not to exceed 10 members total from each country.

2) The host country shall be allowed to enter more than one team.

3) The final Entry Forms must reach ASTA no later than July 31, 2014, rmd1234@AOL.com

4) A maximum of 12 teams *(including USA)* are to be considered based on "First come First Served".

11. Competition Rules:

- 1) The Event shall be conducted according to the playing rules of soft tennis approved by ISTF.
- 2) The official language for this event shall be English.
- 12. Playing level:
 - 1) At Adult level, soft tennis Beginners are not to be considered. Medium high players level is to be suggested.
 - 2) At Junior level the rule is not to be considered.
- **13. Competitions:**
 - 1) Individual Men Singles Individual Women Singles 9 games
 - 2) Individual Junior Singles 7 games
 - 3) Individual Men Doubles Individual Women Doubles 9 games
 - 4) Individual Junior Doubles 7 games
 - 5) Finals for both men & women singles the best of 3 (three) sets

IMPORTANT – due to special circumstances formats of events may be changed!

14. Balls: All games will be played using Kenko Balls.

15. Commendations: after the final of each event the prizes will be awarded for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} place.

- 16. Expenses covered:
 - a) Hotel lodging multi bed rooms five nights players, manager, coaches and mates
 - b) Hotel lodging single bed rooms five nights For the dignitaries only
 - c) Local transportation airport/hotel hotel/courts sight seeing hotel/airport
